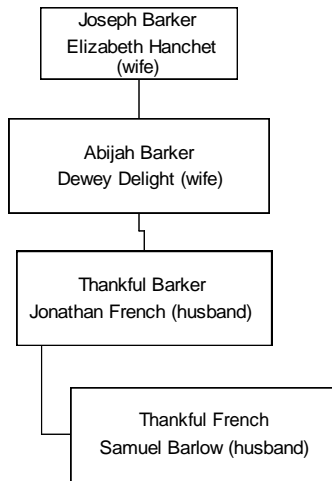

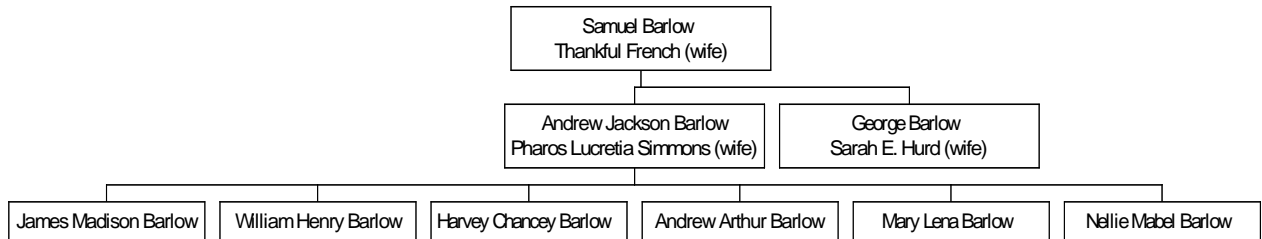

PASSES TO GREAT BEYOND, SUCCUMBS TO THE GREAT DESTROYER

GENESEEE, PA -Mrs. George Barlow died at her home here Sunday morning. The cause of death was pneumonia together with serious heart trouble. The deceased had been in poor health for a long time but was seriously sick but three days before her death.

She was 62 years of age. She leaves to mourn her loss a husband and 9 children, sons Vinne and George both of Genesee and 7 daughters. Mrs. Maggie Ellsworth of Genesee, Mrs. Eva Ryan of Wellsville, Mrs. Emma Eldridge of Hickox, Mrs. Myrtle Stanand of Shinglehouse, Mrs. Millie Sherwood of Wellsville, Mrs. Phoebe Sherwood of Wellsville and Mrs. Jennie Denals of Genesee. There also survive sisters Mrs. Louise Leilous (?) of Belmont and Mrs. Minerva Burdick of Bolivar, brothers, Alphonso Hurd of Bolivar, Rapert Hurd of Richburg and Eugene Hurd of Montour Falls.

Sarah Hurd Barlow was born in Willing township, NY June 12, 1847. She was married to George Barlow in March 1865. 12 children were born to them, 9 of whom survive her. Her life has been spent in Genesee and immediate vicinity and she was known to everyone and was a highly respected woman with a host of friends. She will be missed much by the mourning family and friends.

The funeral services were held Wednesday morning. The interment was in the Genesee cemetery.

VETERAN DIES AT GENESEE AFTER A SHORT ILLNESS FROM STROKE OF APOPLEXY,
WAS A LIFE-LONG RESIDENT

GENESEE, PA - George Barlow of Genesee, passed away at his home Sunday evening, July 24th. The cause of death was apoplexy and came after an illness of two weeks. The deceased had been in poor health for many months, however, and his death was not entirely unexpected.

His wife died about three months ago. He is survived by nine children, seven daughters and two sons. He has lived most of his life in Genesee section and was an old soldier. The funeral services were held Wednesday afternoon at 10 o'clock at the Methodist church with Rev. I. R. Peacock officiating. J. W. Courtright had charge of the interment which was in Genesee Cemetery.

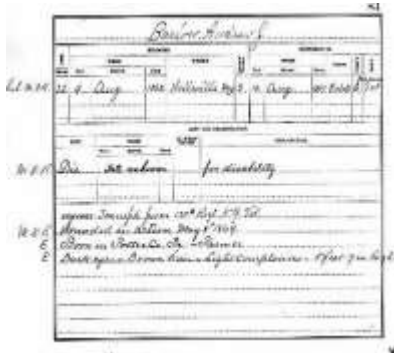

POTTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA. FRIDAY, MAY 27, 1910
DESPONDENCY FROM ILL HEALTH LEADS VETERAN TO SUICIDE
BINGHAM MAN HANGS HIMSELF WITH ROPE FROM SMALL PINE TREE
DOG LEADS SEARCHERS TO THE BODY

Andrew J. Barlow, of Bingham township, committed suicide on Tuesday by hanging himself from a pine tree in the woods back of his house.

Mr. Barlow had been in poor health for some time and for the past year had been the victim of a cancerous growth that caused him much pain and worry. An operation last Fall removed the growth but recently the terrible disease started again in another part of the jaw. He had been very despondent of late and had made remarks that would intimate that he intended self destruction. Financial difficulties also added to his despondency.

On Tuesday morning he took his cane and with his dog climbed the steep hill in the rear of the house to the woods on the top of the hill. This was about nine o'clock in the morning. At noon his absence was noted but nothing serious thought of it. When he did not return by supper time fears were entertained by the family. At about this time the dog came home and after eating his supper showed that he wished the men to follow him. Arthur and Henry, the two

sons, followed the dog up the hill, where he finally led them to the dead body hanging from a small pine tree. The branches were low and the unfortunate man had raised himself up in the limbs, had tied the rope to the tree and around his neck and had let himself down.

The neighbors were aroused and Undertaker Courtright and Justice All's of this place were notified by telephone and they went at once to the scene of the tragedy. Upon their arrival the body was at once cut down. The body was cold indicating he had been dead for a number of hours. The neck was not broken and death undoubtedly resulted from strangulation.

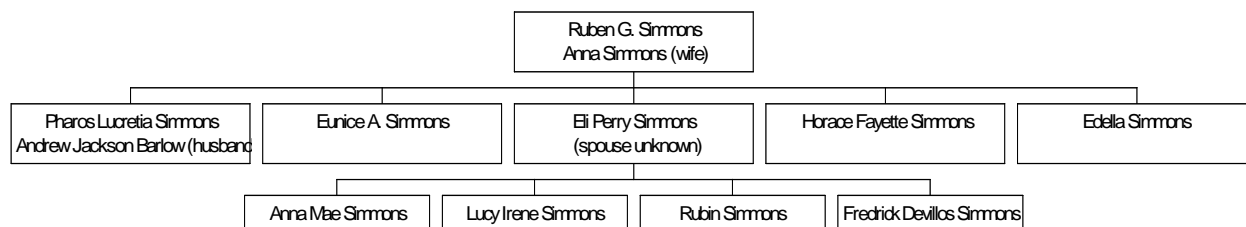
An inquest was held Wednesday morning at the house and a verdict of suicide was brought in after considering all the evidence. The funeral services were held at the M.E. Church at this place Thursday afternoon. Rev. I.R. Peacock officiated.

Andrew Jackson Barlow was born March 20, 1838 in Cattaraugus County, NY. He was a son of Samuel Barlow and Thankful French. Most of his life was spent in this section.

He enlisted in the war of the rebellion in 1862 and served until 1864 when he was given his discharge for disability. He was a member of Co. A of the 24th veteran reserve Corps.

He leaves to mourn his loss, a wife, Lucretia, four sons, Henry and Arthur who live at home, James Barlow of Genesee and Harvey Barlow of Richburg, also two daughters, Mary and Nellie both of Richburg. There also survives one brother, George of Genesee.

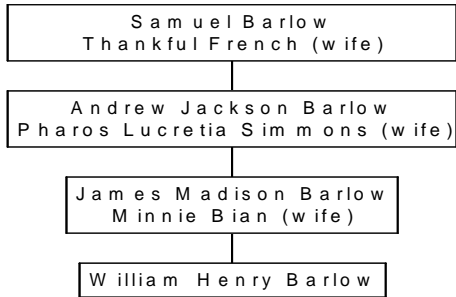

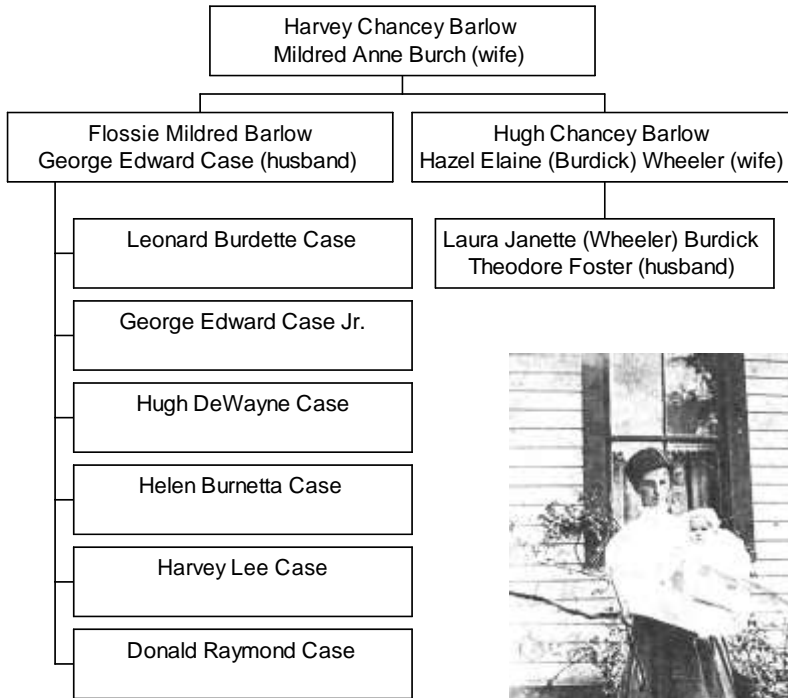

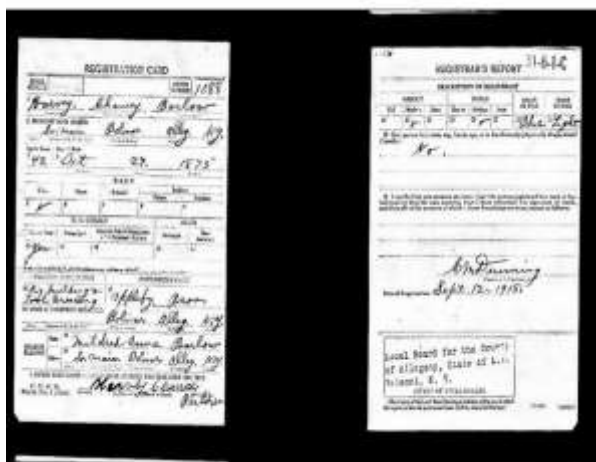

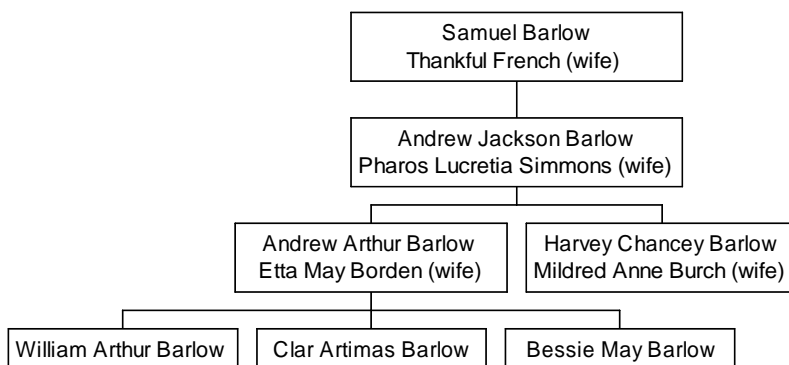

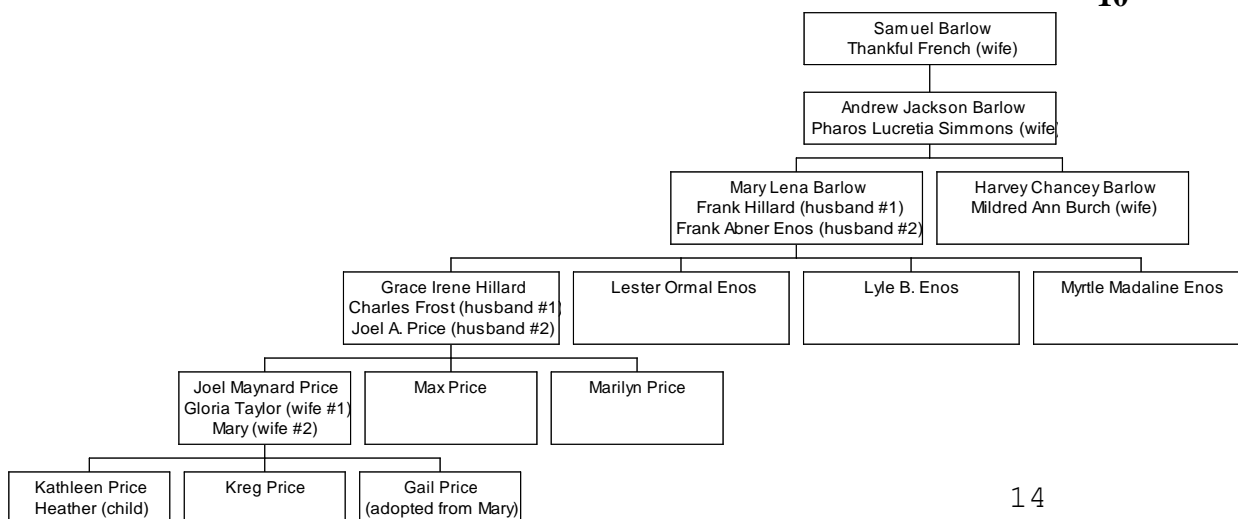
GIRL BURNED TO DEATH
 CLOTHING OF BESSIE BARLOW, 10, CATCHES FIRE FROM KITCHEN
 STOVE

COUDERSPORT, PA, May 17 - The news of the death of the young daughter of Arthur Barlow of Cobb Hill, 11 miles from this place, has just been received here. The girl was Bessie, 10 years old, who is said to have put a quantity of waste paper in the kitchen stove of the isolated farm house when a gust of wind suddenly blew the flames outward and her flimsy dress was ignited. Her screams brought her aged grandmother from the second floor of the home, but not until the girl was completely enveloped in flames. The grandmother wrapped a quilt about the child and the father, hearing the cries, hurried to the house and extinguished the flames. A physician was called from Genesee and gave all the aid possible, but the girl died at 5 o'clock in the afternoon.



She is survived by her father and a brother, slightly her senior, and the aged grandmother.

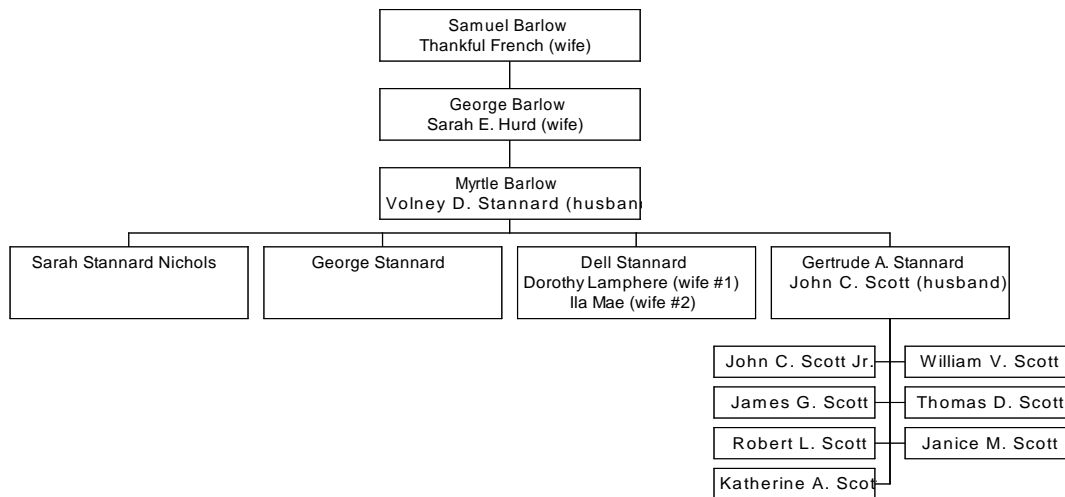
MRS. SARAH HURD BARLOW SUCCUMBS TO THE GREAT DESTROYER

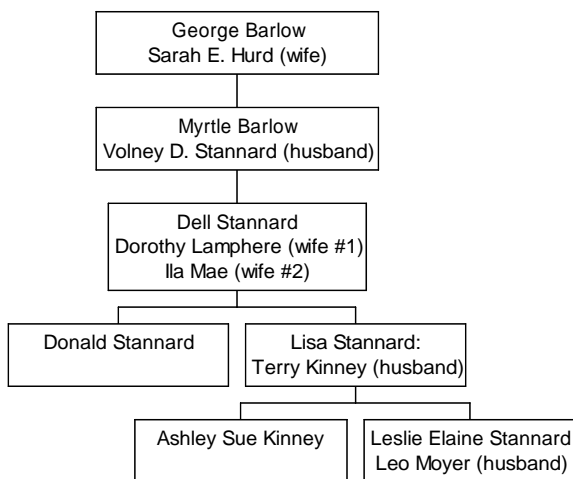

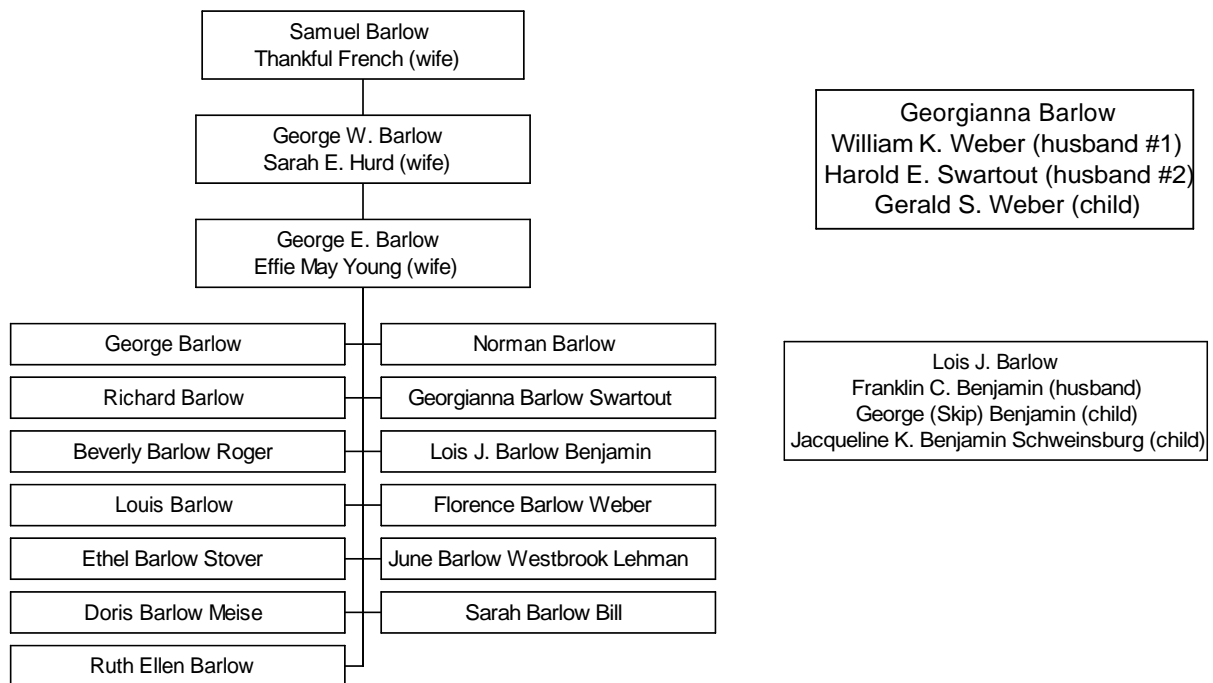
